As you may know, Penn's new student government, the Kingsmen Court, will be coordinating Homecoming this year. Homecoming week will take place from September 26th - September 30th, and the theme will be "Space."

We are adding hallway decorating to Homecoming this year. This is different from the door decorating we have done in the past, which we are still doing this year as a separate component of Homecoming. We are asking the following clubs/organizations to hang up decorations in one hallway each that convey both school spirit and pertain to our space theme:

DECA: balcony over commons to the Writing Center

Student Section: commons

Key Club: Hallway from 152 to cafeteria

Drama Club: sunshine hallway

Any other club that wishes to decorate an additional hallway or area (excluding classroom doors) may do so. The goal of this is to foster team/club spirit and get students and staff excited for the Homecoming culmination on Friday September 30th. Since the space theme is broad, clubs have the freedom to interpret it in any way they choose and can incorporate science fiction media (Star Wars, Star Trek, etc.), the science of space (solar system, Milky Way galaxy), and anything else.

Due to the repainting of the school, regular Scotch-like tape can not be used to hang up decorations. Frog tape or other types of painting tape are acceptable and recommended, and sticky tabs may also be used. Clubs may suspend decorations from the ceiling, but not at the expense of the integrity of our ceiling tile, and nothing may cover the lockers or be low enough to impede people walking through the hallways. While we realize that it is inevitable that some ceiling decorations will be torn/knocked down, we hope to minimize this by hanging things as far out of reach as possible.

Decorations should be hung up after school on Friday September 23rd so that they will be ready for the following week, and each club will have to provide its own materials.
