- 4) Lyrics must be included in the application for approval. Deviation from the printed lyrics is ground for disqualification. Profanity is not allowed -- songs must be acceptable for young and mixed audiences.
- 5) Advertising or communicating negative messages about other bands is not allowed.
- 6) ANY inappropriate behavior (i.e. crowd surfing, destroying instruments or equipment) will be grounds for disqualification.
- 7) All members of the band are bound to the Penn High School Code of Conduct while on Penn property.
- 8) The battle of the Bands committee and advisors will retain the right and the responsibility of the event. At any point that decisions are made, they will be accepted by the participants.
